Dear Parent/Carers,

To celebrate the end of your child's first year at Bacon's College students will be attending a trip to Stubbers Adventure Centre in Upminster on **Monday 22**<sup>nd</sup> **July.** 

The intention of this visit is to give them the opportunity to develop personally in preparation for Year 8 with the help of fun controlled activities which focus on teamwork, communication skills and physical fitness.

At the venue, students will take part in a variety of activities. These will be led by trained staff of Stubbers Adventure Centre. Students will be supervised throughout by Stubbers and Bacon's College staff. Stubbers' multi-activity days consist of numerous activity zone sessions of 1 hour each in length. They will produce a multi-activity programme subject to activity availability. Some activities that could be on the programme are listed below:

- Climbing/ Abseiling
- Laser combat
- Rifle shooting
- Archery
- Raft Building
- High ropes course
- Open Canoeing

Students will be travelling by coach to and from the venue and it is important they arrive at the time stated below to ensure that we arrive on time.

Students will be expected to wear their PE kit for this trip and bring along the following items:

- spare clothes including socks and underwear

- t-shirt
- sweatshirt
- waterproof coat
- swimwear
- towel
- water shoes (old trainers, you don't mind getting wet is fine)
- closed toe footwear for activities
- sun hat/woolly hat (weather dependent)
- plastic bags for wet/dirty clothing

## PLEASE DO NOT BRING ANY ITEMS OF CLOTHING THAT YOU WOULD MIND GETTING RUINED. ALL CLOTHES WILL GET WET AND DIRTY. NO JEWELLERY IS TO BE WORN.
