Dear Parent/ Carer,

A-level Geography trip letter to Hyde Park

I am pleased to inform you that your child has the opportunity to take part in an educational trip to The Look Out Discovery Centre in Hyde Park. The purpose of this trip is to complete a full day session for Fieldwork studies on the Carbon and Water cycle unit. **This is a compulsory fieldwork day as students must complete at least 4 days fieldwork as part of their A-level Geography course.**

The trip will take place on **Thursday 18th January** from **10am-3pm** in **Hyde Park**. We will be leaving from school at 9 so students must come into school for normal time (8.30am). We will be getting to the venue by tube, the transport is covered by TfL so **no charges will apply on the day.**

Students must wear **comfortable and warm clothing**. Much of the day will be spent outdoors, due to cooler temperatures please ensure your child brings a **warm jacket** and **plenty of layers**. It is strongly advised that students also bring **gloves**. Students will be walking within Hyde Park so please make sure suitable footwear is warm, students may get these muddy.

Please make sure your child brings a packed lunch or money to buy lunch from a shop on the way to Canada Water tube station, once at Hyde Park there will be no opportunity to buy food. If your child is entitled to free school meals this will be provided on the morning of the trip.

Students should arrive back at Canada water around 3.30pm and will be dismissed from there. **If you would like to give permission for your child to be dismissed at Hyde Park or before we reach Canada Water tube station, please email Miss Hickman confirming this.** Please note, if your child leaves prior to Canada Water station, they will have to pay for this part of the travel.
