#### **Academic Excellence and Homework**

#### Mid-Year Exams

Year 7-10 mid-year assessments and exams will be from 16<sup>th</sup> December 2024 – 17<sup>th</sup> January 2025.

This half term and the first week of next half term is a pivotal time for our students, with exams having begun this week. Our priority is to ensure that each student feels well-prepared and supported to achieve their best in these upcoming assessments. All exam dates and revision materials are on satchel one/ show my homework.

**English** - Years 7-9 will sit their assessments in class between the 16th of December and the 10th of January.

Maths - Years 7-9 will sit their exams in the Main Hall between the 13th-17th of January. All other exams will take place in lessons; therefore, it is vital students aim to maintain 100% attendance not only to ensure they are to learn the content of the exams but also are in to take them.

Homework is key to ensuring your child is revising regularly and stretching their learning further.

## Homework Club

Homework Club is available to all students during the Library's opening hours listed below.

We encourage students to attend Homework Club or speak with their teachers if they have any questions before their homework deadlines.




## **Pupil charter**
