## Year 9 Parents' and Options Evening

I am writing to invite you to two important events for your child. Please note that the dates and times of these events have been modified from what was previously advertised.

## Year 9 Parents' Evening, Tuesday 6th February 4.00-6.30pm (last entry 6.10pm)

Parents' Evening will take place on **Thursday 6th February.** This is an important evening where you will meet your child's subject teachers, who will explain and discuss their current achievement, progress, and give advice on their option choices.

We expect all students and parents to attend. Students should wear school uniform. If you cannot attend, you will need to email Ms Johnson to arrange a meeting/contact teachers. Reports will not be given to students if they attend without a parent/responsible adult.

## GCSE Options Information Evening: Thursday 29th February, 4-5.30pm

Following this, I would also like to invite you to the launch of the GCSE Options Process on Thursday, February 29<sup>th</sup> at 4pm. During this presentation, you will be informed about the structure of the Key Stage 4 curriculum for next year and we will be explaining how best to select the options most appropriate for your child, including how to complete their options form. There will also be a presence from the Curriculum Leaders for all subjects and members of the Senior Leadership Team to answer questions and provide advice.

Upon your arrival to the GCSE options information evening, you will also receive the following:

- 1. An **Information Booklet** which provides you with key information and addresses the most frequently raised queries from students, parents, and carers.
- 2. A collated booklet of **Subject Information Sheets**. These provide details of the course content and assessment model for the subjects we offer at Key Stage 4. There are also suggestions for complementary subjects and potential career pathways for each subject.
- 3. A copy of the **Options Form** for the Pathway we believe your child is most suited for, based on the most recent data that we have. Full details of what these pathways mean and how they were decided can be found in the aforementioned **Information Booklet**.





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All the materials listed, along with a copy of the Options Evening presentation will also be made available on our website following the event.

We hope that these two events will provide the foundations for the important decisions that we will need to make together in build-up to your son or daughter's GCSE studies.
