Dear parents/guardians,

It was fantastic to see so many of you in person on Thursday for our Year 11 information evening. A text and email will be sent out with the PowerPoint and key take aways. In summary, the main points are:

- We have a strong culture of support for our 11 and want them to 'aim high'. We celebrate all the good things they do but we also have high expectations on behaviour, punctuality and homework completion
- Evidence has shown that Parental engagement with their child's learning can add the equivalent of 4 months to a student's progress
- When it comes to revision, we gave year 11 the following messages:
 - Use your revision schedule to find a minimum of 14 hours per week of study. This still gives you plenty of free time.
 - Study in silence phones, music and TV cause too much distraction and no, you cannot multitask!
 - o Use the revision schedule we've given you to guide you on what to revise
 - Revision should always be a 2-step process
 - 1. Learning the information, cover it and write down what you remember
 - 2. Apply what you have learnt by answering questions
- For a selected number of students, we will run extra Saturday morning sessions. A letter will be sent to you from Ms Anum with further information
- Sixth Form open evening will be held on Thursday 10th October

Weekly revision tip

How to make knowledge stick?

1. Teach Someone Else

Why: Teaching is one of the most effective ways to solidify your understanding of a topic.

How: Explain what you've learned to a friend, family member, or even to yourself out loud. If you can teach it, you've truly understood it!

2. Tackle Any Confusion Early

Why: It's easier to address confusion sooner rather than later, before it becomes a bigger issue.

How: If there's something you didn't quite grasp during the lesson, make a note of it and ask your teacher or classmates for help as soon as possible. Don't wait until the day before an exam to sort it out!
