
A week in the life of Year 11


Dear Parents/Carers,

This week saw the final of the November PPE's. Students continued to show resilience throughout this week, displaying fantastic focus and effort towards the last of their examinations. On Tuesday, there was a Sixth Form 'taster day', as well as a Post-16 Pathways Day.

Students who took part in the Post-16 Pathways Day had an action-packed day, which first started with an assembly given by Mrs Anum, consisting of an overview of the different pathways available to students, depending on academic outcomes. The students then took part in 3 workshops designed to help them think about their career pathways and the skills needed in any career. Firstly, we had a Finance workshop delivered by the MAN group. This focused on financial literacy as well as teambuilding through some interactive activities. Secondly, the students had a workshop led by Construction Youth. They explored different roles within the construction industry and built their own bridges which were tested for strength and durability. Finally, they had a College application workshop led by our Careers Advisor Ms Watson. They were able to explore a variety of different courses at different schools and get support with applying for them. Overall, the feedback from the presenters was that the students were positive, engaged and asked really interesting questions. See below some photos taken from the Pathways Day:







Students who took part in the Sixth Form taster day also started their day with an information assembly, led by the Head of Sixth Form, Mr Foley. During which, students learnt about the different subjects offered, entry requirements, application process and what life is like for a Bacon's College Sixth Form student. Prior to the taster day, students had selected subjects of interest, throughout the day, students had 50 minutes taster sessions of these subjects. Here, students learnt more about the courses offered at Bacon's, as well as experiencing a snippet of an A- level lesson. 
The graphic above highlights some key statistics linked to attendance.
