Careers talk:

On Tuesday, Year 7 had a careers assembly with Leah Chowdhry, who discussed the topics of resilience, the importance of mindset and asking students to find their why in what they do. She is the first British Asian woman to swim across the English Channel and in doing so raised over £250,000 for numerous challenges. She is also the founder and CEO of Pop up, Party & Play, a mobile childcare company. Furthermore, she is the author of children's book 'Making a Splash!', helping children to adopt a similar attitude and teaching them the importance of self-belief. At the end of the talk, she gave students the homework of firstly changing 'I can't' to 'I can' and secondly to do something kind for someone else.

Her talk was very inspiring and lots of students were left with many questions for her.

In Science club this week students were tasked with making the perfect oobleck, a suspension of corn flour and water. Oobleck can behave like a solid or liquid depending on how much pressure you apply.





Pupil charter

The start of the new academic year sees the launch of the Bacon's Pupil Charter for all year groups.
