Re- Outward-Bound trip, 24th-28th March 2025

We have secured 36 funded places for students to attend Outward Bound. This is a one-week residential outdoor activity centre that teaches team building, confidence and resilience in the Welsh countryside. It will take place at Ogwen Cottage in Wales. Students will travel by coach on Monday 24th of March at around 8.00am arriving there by 1.00pm. They will return on Friday 28th of March by approximately 6.00pm. All meals are provided, but students will need a packed lunch for the first day. This is a really great opportunity, and we hope that students will really benefit and have a great new experience by taking part. Please read the leaflet attached which summarises the key activities and goals.

A meeting to go through more details and items students need to pack will be held after half term. A date will be confirmed soon.

The majority of the trip has been funded and subsidised by the Outward Bound trust and the school so the **final cost for students is £150.** You would need to pay £50 by February 21st. Due to the late notice, the payment deadline for the remainder of the money is **Friday 30th of May 2025.**
