Dear Parent/ Guardian,

The rewards policy at Bacon's College provides an opportunity to acknowledge the achievements of students in their studies and extracurricular activities. Throughout the academic year student successes are acknowledged and celebrated in several different forms including half-termly rewards assemblies. When students reach certain positive point thresholds, they have been awarded with bronze, silver, and gold awards.
