Re: Year 11 Saturday School

It was fantastic to see so many of you at last week's Parent Information Evening and thank you for the ongoing support you provide as we work to support your child through Year 11.

Starting this Saturday, 5th October, there will be Saturday school for a select number of students each week. Between now and the Christmas holidays, these classes will be primarily aimed at coursework-based subjects with a view to getting all coursework completed as early in the year as possible. These Saturday morning sessions provide the opportunity to focus intensively on a specific subject. Although priority is currently going to coursework subjects, later in the year (up to June 2025) these sessions will be used to practice and enhance exam technique in preparation for exams.

All Saturday classes run from 9.45am-1.15pm. Students are permitted to wear their own clothes and can bring their own drinks and snacks for the day. Students must come on time and be prepared to work. Anyone who arrives extremely late, may be sent home.

Parents will be notified via SMS on Tuesdays and Fridays in advance of the Saturday class and students will be informed at school during line up or assembly. We expect students to attend all classes they have been allocated to. Saturday school is supervised by Ms Adewunmi and Mr J. Mathan. If your child is running late or has not arrived and we have not been notified, they will call you to find out where they are.
