It was wonderful to welcome all students back to school yesterday and see lessons commence. I am really optimistic that this year will be a great one for Bacon's as we strive for excellence.

Exam results were excellent in the summer, the first time that public exams have actually been sat since 2019. At A level 38% of grades were A*/A and 70% were A*-B. Our results place us in the top 10% of schools nationally. Many students secured places at Russell Group universities, including Oxford.

GCSE results were also very impressive with 79% of students achieving 5+ grades 9-4 including English and Mathematics. This represents a 10% increase on 2019.

Chromebooks

We will be resuming independent study time (IST) next week on a Tuesday and Wednesday. Year 7 will be issued with their Chromebooks on Wednesday 14th September.

The Chromebook is part of a student's basic equipment and must be brought to school every day. They are not heavy and are compact enough to be carried in a school bag. The battery life is sufficient to last a day in school, but they must be charged at home ready for each day.
