16 to 19 Tuition Fund Statement

Purpose: The 16 to 19 tuition fund, launched in July 2020, is funding for the 2020 to 2021 academic year, it is ring fenced funding for schools, colleges and all other 16 to 19 providers to mitigate the disruption to learning arising from coronavirus (COVID-19).

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Bacon's College Sixth Form has allocated the funding towards our ICT support package to students. The College has bought a further 15 laptops specifically for sixth form use at the cost of £150.00 per device.

This has enabled our disadvantaged young people to engage in learning and continue their studies whilst working at home, both during periods of self-isolation in the autumn term and during the lockdown in the spring term.

Throughout the lockdown of January and February of 2021 these extra devices and stationery have kept our young people engaged and connected both virtually and physically due to the fact that some students have limited or no equipment at home. This allows our students to access live lessons and to continue taking part in high quality teaching and learning.
