Dear Parents/Carers,

As we approach the end of the academic year, I am writing to inform you about the upcoming End of Year (EOY) assessments for students in Years 7–10 and 12. These assessments are an important opportunity for students to demonstrate their learning and progress across the year.

Please find attached the examination timetable along with subject-specific revision lists, which are intended to support your child in preparing effectively for their assessments.

Key Dates

- Week beginning **Monday 8th June: Year 10 (and Year 12)**. Please note that Year 10 French and Spanish speaking exams will take place in lessons in the week beginning Monday 1st June.
- Week beginning **Monday 15th June: All year groups (Years 7–10 and 12)**
During this week, students will be off timetable, but the school timings will run as normal.

Please note that in a small number of cases, some assessments may take place in lessons after this period. Teachers will communicate any such arrangements via Satchel.

Expectations During the Assessment Period

Throughout the assessment period, students are expected to attend school in full and correct uniform. The school's **usual behaviour policy will remain in place**, and we will continue to expect the same high standards of conduct that are expected during the regular school day.

Students should also be aware that there may be periods during the day in the second week of assessments when they are not in an exam. During these times, they will be expected to revise independently. It is therefore essential that **students bring appropriate revision materials** with them each day, such as exercise books, revision guides, flashcards and any other notes that will support their preparation.

If students wish to use their Chromebooks to support their revision, they are welcome to do so. However, it is their responsibility to ensure that their device is fully charged each day and that they bring their charger with them. Students will not be able to share devices or chargers with others.

Finally, it is essential that **students come fully equipped** for each examination. They should ensure they have all necessary equipment, including pens, pencils, rulers and calculators where required. Spare equipment will not be available in classrooms, so preparation in advance is crucial.

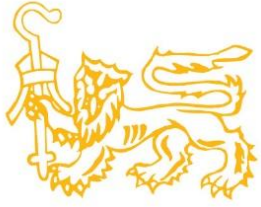
