Dear parent/guardians,

At Bacon's College our aim is to provide an environment conducive to learning and for all lessons to be disruption free, so that success can be maximised for every child. To ensure standards remain high, staff regularly visit lessons to monitor the culture and climate of lessons. In most lessons students are engaged and focussed on the tasks set by their class teacher and are working hard. There is a strong culture of achievement at Bacon's College.

Unfortunately, a minority of students receive two warnings in lessons which disrupts the flow of teaching and learning. To reduce these incidents in lessons we will be moving to a 'warn and remove' system from Monday 27th November at key stage 4 (year 10/11). This means that if a student disrupts learning they will receive a first warning to re-focus their attention, but any further misdemeanours which disrupt their learning will result in a referral to the isolation room. Our behaviour policy will be updated accordingly.

At a pivotal time in your child's education, I am sure you can understand our rationale for this decision. We want students to utilise every minute of every lesson without disruption. Should you have any further questions please do contact your child's head of year at your earliest convenience.
