## A-level Geography trip to Brick Lane

I am pleased to inform you that your child has the opportunity to take part in an educational trip to brick Lane. The purpose of this trip is to complete a full day session for Fieldwork studies on the Carbon and gentrification of the area. This is a compulsory fieldwork day.

The trip will take place on **Tuesday 24th January** from **9am-4pm** in Brick lane. We will be leaving from school at 8.45am so students must come into school for normal time (8.30am). We will be getting to the venue by tube, the transport is covered by TfL so **no charges will apply on the day**.

Students must wear comfortable and warm clothing. Much of the day will be spent outdoors, due to cooler temperatures please ensure your child brings a warm jacket and plenty of layers. It is strongly advised that students also bring gloves. Students will be walking within Brick Lane, so please make sure suitable footwear is worn.

Please make sure your child brings a packed lunch. If your child is entitled to free school meals this will be provided on the morning of the trip.

If you would like to give permission for your child to be dismissed at Brick Lane or before we reach Canada Water tube station, please email Mr Marzano confirming this. Please note, if your child leaves prior to Canada Water station, they will have to pay for this part of their travel.
