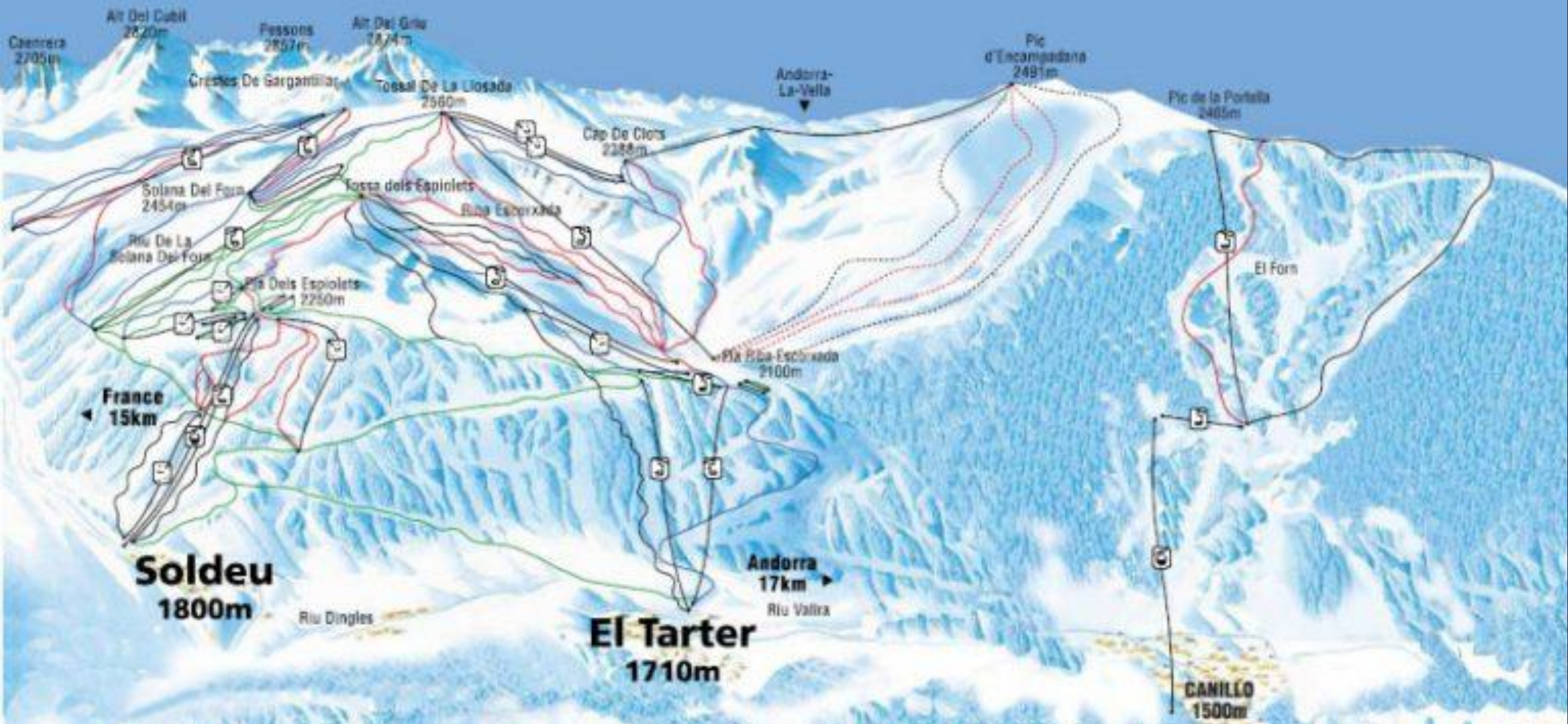

If anyone is travelling under a non-UK passport, it is entirely the parents' responsibility to ensure the student has the correct visas for entry to the EU.

Trip criteria:

To be considered for the trip every student must have excellent attendance and behaviour:

- There are **45 spaces** in total
- Spaces will be given on a **first come first** served basis
- Students will not be considered for the trip if attendance is **below 90%**
- Students will not be considered for the trip if they have accumulated **5 or more negative points** (isolation referrals).
