## End of Year exams: vears 10 & 12

Students will be sitting their end of year exams in June – please see the timetable <u>here</u>. For Year 10, the results in these exams will influence set changes for year 11; for Year 12, it may affect whether they stay into year 13.

## Revision topics, homework and coursework

Year 10 exam topics can be found <a href="here">here</a> to aid with revision. Year 12 will be advised of their topics, by their subject teachers. Homework will be suspended from the 2<sup>nd</sup> of June-13<sup>th</sup> of June to give students time to revise. **Students will resume submitting homework from the 19<sup>th</sup> of June**. Students in year 10 and 12 must continue to complete any coursework (if relevant) in their own time.

## Equipment

Students should bring all of their own equipment including black pens, pencils, ruler, rubber, maths set, calculator, highlighters, and water bottles. Phones must be switched off during exams so I would advise you not to call your child until after 3.15pm as some afternoon exams may overrun. Watches (or any kind) are not allowed and must be handed into the teacher at the start of the exam and will be returned at the end. Students must bring their Chromebook, a reading book and revision materials every day during the two weeks of exams.
